

# Memorandum of Agreement

In 2006, the American Indian community entered into a historic Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Minneapolis Public Schools. This document outlines the goal to dramatically improve academic achievement and graduation rates of American Indian students.

A renewed MOA was approved in 2012, strengthening our community partnerships, strategies, and accountability.

The MOA established Indigenous best practice sites characterized by the integration of cultural relevance with academic rigor. Anishinabe Academy, South High All Nations, and Nawayee Center School are currently identified as best practice sites in the MOA.
